## Frequently Asked Questions

- **How much is the class?**

The cost is \$80 per person, however if two people register together, the cost is \$150 for both of you (saves \$10!).

- **How long is the class?**

The class is 8 weeks long and meets one evening a week for 2 hours at a time.

- **Can my children take this class?**

Our classes are geared toward an adult population. Because our classes are in the evening and 2 hours in duration, we discourage children under the age of 12 from participating. Typically, a 10 minute break is allowed each class, but we find that it is difficult for younger children to sit through an entire session

- **Can I register for more than one class in case my first choice gets cancelled due to low enrollment?**

Yes, please indicate both your first and second location choice on the registration form. We will do all we can to ensure the location of your choice, but in the event we need to cancel due to low enrollment, we will give you the option of a refund or enrollment into another class.

## In-Services

If you have a large group of people, we would be happy to set up an in-service for you. We can work with any group including offices, school groups, scout groups, etc. and are able to cover a variety of topics:

Sign Language Basics

Deaf History

Deaf Culture

Working with a Deaf individual

Adaptive Technology

Typically, our in-services are one day and are 2 hours in length. The cost is \$150 per session however; special rates may apply if more than one day is scheduled.

We can also set up an 8 week sign language class exclusively for your group. The cost will be the same as the other classes we offer (\$80/person) but we can come to your location and meet at a time that is convenient for you!
